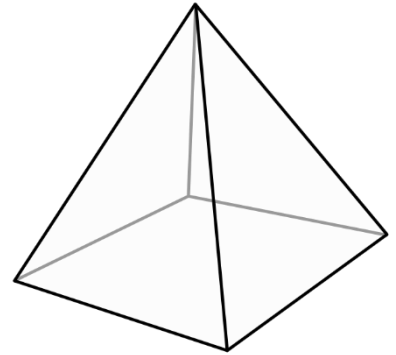

Directions:

- A tri-orama is a pyramid made of four sides of triangular paper that will look like a pyramid when it is attached all together.

- Choose **at least three topics from the list below**. Feel free to group some of the similar topics:
