<b>C</b>	<b>Cite Evidence</b>  relevant: related  compelling: powerful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can use transition words by referring to the "What does the text <b>SAY</b>?" writing prompts.</li> <li>I can use information from the text to prove my answer.</li> <li>I can use ONE <b>relevant and compelling quote</b> from the text to prove my answer.
