<b>Writing Prompt Question:</b>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can write the Writing Prompt Question (and page number if applicable).</li> </ul> <p>Why does the author consider chocolate to be "medicine"? (Highlight key words.)</p>
<b>R</b>	<b>Restate the Question</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can restate the question in my own words using the <b>KEY WORDS</b>.</li> </ul>
<b>A</b>	<b>Answer the Question</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can answer the question accurately.</li> <li>I can write an introduction that is at least four sentences long.</li> </ul>
<b>C</b>	<b>Cite Evidence</b>  relevant: related  compelling: powerful	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can use transition words by referring to the "What does the text <b>SAY</b>?" writing prompts.</li> <li>I can use information from the text to prove my answer.</li> <li>I can use <b>ONE relevant and compelling quote</b> from the text to prove my answer.
