TASK:

- 1) Write an essay comparing and contrasting character traits of two revolutionary men.
- 2) Compare one of your character traits to a trait of at least one of the men that you have chosen to write about.

- 2) Read and annotate two of the magazines about revolutionary men.
- **3**) As you are **reading and annotating**, think about the following questions:
 - Which two revolutionary men do you wish to analyze and write about?
 - What are traits that characterize these two revolutionary men?
 - What are some similar character traits that you and these men both possess?
- **4)** Decide on ONE or TWO traits that characterize one revolutionary man (Thomas Jefferson, George Washington, or Ben Franklin).

- 5) Highlight four or five pieces of EVIDENCE (quotes and/or facts) that PROVES and supports the traits that you infer that represent this man.
- **6)** Decide on ONE or TWO traits that characterize another revolutionary man (Thomas Jefferson, George Washington, or Ben Franklin).
- 7) Highlight four or five pieces of EVIDENCE (quotes and/or facts) that PROVES and supports the traits that you infer that represent this man.
- 8) Write an essay comparing and contrasting the character traits of two revolutionary men.
- 9) Use evidence from the text to prove your inferences comparing and contrasting the character traits of these two revolutionary men.
- 10) Also, in one of your paragraphs, describe how you have a similar character trait of one of the revolutionary men.
- 11) Be sure to have an introduction, at least three body paragraphs, and a conclusion.
