TASK:

- 1) Write an essay describing one or two character traits of one or two revolutionary women.**
- 2) Compare one of your character traits to a trait of at least one of the women that you have chosen to write about.**

DIRECTIONS:

- 1) Annotate the directions.**
- 2) Read and annotate** at least two articles about revolutionary women.
- 3) As you are reading and annotating**, think about the following questions:
 - Which woman or women do you wish to write about?
 - What are traits that characterize these revolutionary women?
 - What are some similar character traits that you and these women both possess?
- 4) Decide on ONE or TWO traits that characterize one revolutionary woman.**
- 5) Highlight EVIDENCE that PROVES and supports the traits that you infer that represent this woman.**
- 6) Highlight four or five pieces of evidence (quotes or facts that prove or support the traits you infer that represent this woman).**

- 7) Decide on ONE or TWO traits that characterize another revolutionary woman.
- 8) Highlight EVIDENCE that PROVES and supports the traits that you infer that represent this other woman.
- 9) Highlight four or five pieces of evidence (quotes or facts that prove or support the traits you infer that represent this second woman).
- 10) Write an essay describing one or two character traits of one or two revolutionary women.
- 11) Use evidence from the text to prove your inference of character trait or traits that this woman or women possess.
- 12) **Also, in one of your paragraphs, describe how you have a similar character trait of this woman (or women).**
- 13) Be sure to have an introduction, at least three body paragraphs, and a conclusion.
- 14) Use the RACEEECEEECEEEER Graphic Organizer to help you write the most informative essay that you are able.
- 15) Use the RACEEECEEECEEEER Rubric to help you write the most informative essay that you are able.
