Hello, my name is Ms. Richardson and I would love to tell you a little bit about myself.


Something I am looking forward to this school year is getting to know all of you.

Usually I work multiple summer jobs and am stuck inside a lot, but this summer was different because of the pandemic.


Instead of working so much, I got to make awesome memories with my family doing activities like hiking, camping, and swimming in the lake near my house.

I love that my family members are some of my best friends and favorite people to be around.




If someone asked me to describe myself I would say that I am an introvert who likes people.
