  - plateaus
  - plains
  - deltas
  - mountains
  - volcanoes
  - oceans
  - beaches
  - marshland
- **Find out the climate of your state.**  
While using weather.com, keep track of the highs and lows of temperature. Organize your findings in a graph or chart. Write a paragraph or more describing the climate.

**CHECKLIST:  
TIPS FOR CREATING YOUR GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURES POWERPOINT**

- Create a **title page**. For example:

Geographical Features and Climate of Texas

Created by: Lucy Loves-to-Read

- Create a **table of contents**.
- **On each slide**, type some interesting information about each geographical feature.
- **On each slide**, add photos, maps, and/or graphs. Be sure to **add the website** (on which you found each photo) under each photo.
- **Definitions**: Be sure to add the definition of each geographical feature **on the bottom of each slide**. **DO NOT COPY AND PASTE THE DEFINITION. PUT THE DEFINITION IN YOUR OWN WORDS.**
- Be sure that you are using white font on a very dark background, or black font on a white or light background. Yellow font isn't usually ever a good idea.
- Be sure your font size is big enough to read well.
- **DO NOT COPY AND PASTE INFORMATION FROM THE INTERNET!** That is plagiarism and is illegal. Put all of the information in your own words.
- **Number and label each slide**. For example:

- Slide One: Title Page
- Slide Two: Table of Contents
- Slide Three: Geographical Map of Texas
- Slide Four: Geographic Features
- Slide Five: Mountains
- Slide Six: Rivers
- Slide Seven: Lakes
- Slide Eight: Oceans
- Slide Nine: Beaches
- Slide Ten: Volcanoes
- Slide Eleven: Islands
- Slide Twelve: Climate and Weather
- Slide Thirteen: Climate Map of Texas
- Slide Fourteen: Monthly Weather Graph of Texas
- Slide Fifteen: Closing Slide
